

Maintaining Your Canadian Certified Parking Facility Manager (CCPFM) Certification

Certification is valid for 3 years, after which time, re-certification is required. This ensures that the professional designation maintains its validity in the market. Recertification is achieved by completing and accumulating three points from any combination of the following exercises within a three-year period, starting from the date of certification.

2 points each:

- Publish an article in The Parker
- Present a paper at the annual Conference & Trade Show

1 point each:

- Attend the annual Conference & Trade Show
- Participate on a local Conference host committee
- Conduct a Parking Professional Primer (PPP) training session with your staff

1/2 point each:

- Participate in a District Chapter meeting
- Recruit new member to CPA
- Submit a nomination for the annual Canadian Parking Foundation Awards
- Be a member in good standing (maintain continuous membership).
