



Are you thinking about writing an article for the Parker magazine?

Writing an article for the Parker is an excellent way to gain recognition, earn points towards your CCPFM recertification or other professional development and to share your expertise with fellow parking professionals. If you have something to say about timely, relevant topics in parking, you are encouraged to submit contributions.

Articles can be submitted at any time for consideration in a future issue.

Submission Requirements

Length: Feature articles 1,000 – 2,000 words; Announcements 250 – 1000 words

Format: Submit the article in a Microsoft Word Rich Text Format (RTF), 12-point Times New Roman font, free from any stylized formatting (such as underlining, shading, etc.). Include a title and a by-line, plus subheads for feature-length articles.

Exclusivity: Exclusive submissions are preferred, but if your article has already appeared in another publication, please indicate the name of the publication and date it appeared.

Nature of Articles: Submissions must not be commercial in any way that would promote a product, service, or company.

Editing: The Canadian Parking Association reserves the right to edit the content of the article and cannot guarantee placement in a specific issue, nor can guarantee that the article will be published. The author may be required to revise the article before it will be considered for publication.

Images: Photos, graphs and charts are used to enhance the readability and appearance of articles. Images must be high resolution (300 dpi or higher), in .tiff, .jpeg or .eps format. Captions can be included but may not be used in the final document. Images should be sent as separate attachments, and not imbedded in the document.

Authors note: Provide a brief summary about the author that includes the author's name, company and contact information.

2nd Quarter May 1

3rd Quarter July 31

4th Quarter Nov 1
